Self Aid & Buddy Aid for Law Enforcement Officers

The Greenfield Police department, with grant funding from the Western Regional Homeland Security Advisory Council, will be hosting Self Aid & Buddy Aid for Law Enforcement Monday 30 from 0830 – 1630. The course will be conducted by STS Consulting, WWW.TACTICAL-EMS.COM. Lunch will be provided and OEMS credits have been applied for and are pending.

This training will encompass techniques that will enable Law Enforcement Officers to provide self care and buddy care in hostile environments. Participants will learn techniques such as but not limited to conducting self assessments, hemorrhage control, application of tourniquets and the use of improvised bandaging techniques. Course participants will conduct these medical drills with, two hands, single hand, vision impaired and in a variety of positions. Course participants will engage targets down range with their department issue weapons (.40, .45, .223, 5.56 or slugs) from a variety of positions to make the training as realistic as possible.

Participants should be in good physical shape, as the pace of the course will be demanding. Participants must be qualified on their departments issued firearms and may use a handgun and a patrol rifle or shotgun (slug only) if they wish. In addition, participants will need to bring 250 – 300 handgun rounds and 50 – 100 patrol rifle or slug rounds.

Nutmeg Cartridges, Guardian Uniform, Z-Medica, Revision and Pelican Cases have been invited to attend.
